

IN SEARCH OF THE *WILD WITHIN* -

MOCEAN DANCE PARTNERS WITH NOVA SCOTIA TALENT TRUST FOR CREATIVE RESIDENCY AT THE MARIGOLD CULTURAL CENTRE

MARCH 5, 2019 [K'jipuktuk/Halifax] – Mocean Dance's Co-Artistic Director Sara Coffin for her latest creation, *Wild Within*, at the Marigold Cultural Centre in Truro, NS during March 31 – April 5, 2019.

Influenced by Coffin's recent expedition along the Yukon River with the Canadian Wilderness Artist Residency, this new work explores the concept of the wild within, femininity, connecting to the energy of the land, as well as the poetic play between function and decay found in nature's life cycles. *Wild Within* will premiere with Mocean Dance in Fall 2019.

Coffin will be joined by dancers Anastasia Wiebe, Julie Robert, Lydia Zimmer and Georgia Skinner as well as collaborators, multimedia artist Nick Bottomley and composer/interdisciplinary artist Brian Riley as the company experiment with multimedia elements and set design for the new work in the theatre setting.

The Mocean creation residency series is part of the Nova Scotia Talent Trust's 75th Anniversary celebrations. Coffin, Skinner and Zimmer - past program alumnae, will be ambassadors of the Talent Trust program, to help inspire young dancers across the province, inform students of the training scholarship program, as well as offer workshops for the local high school and community members to take in a behind-the-scenes look at the creative process of *Wild Within*.

“To escape the busy work life while working at the Marigold Cultural Centre is a gift to ignite the creative flow that allows time and space for infinite possibilities to arise. I am equally elated to partner with Nova Scotia Talent Trust to help make this creative residency series possible, to share Nova-Scotia based contemporary dance in an intimate setting while promoting both Mocean and NSTT. I have had a twenty-year career in the arts thanks to the professional training opportunities the support from Talent Trust opened up for me as a young dancer. While at Marigold Cultural Centre the community will be invited to a work-in-progress sharing and an artist talk on April 4 to view an intimate behind-the-scenes look into how contemporary dance is made and the process of incorporating multimedia elements to tell a story. On April 5 local high school students and the community are invited for movement workshops, a short performance and talk of the importance of the arts in Atlantic Canada.
